Please note that the purpose of a Special Circumstance Petition is to see if you are eligible for a lower Expected Family Contribution (EFC).  
**Allow a minimum of 8 weeks for review and notification.**

**Submit the following with this form:**

- A signed letter of explanation** detailing the circumstances. Be thorough to avoid delays.
- Supporting documentation**
- If petition is due to loss of employment, attach unemployment benefit document or if not receiving unemployment benefits; include last day worked, severance pay amount and weekly unemployment amount.
  - If student or a family member chose to quit a job, the reason for doing so must be included in the statement.
  - If petition is due to reduced hours of work, note the new hourly rate & number of hours worked each week, as well as a recent pay stub.
  - If the special circumstance was the receipt of a one-time benefit in 2020 that won't be repeated in 2021 (such as receiving an inheritance, cash taken from 401K, etc.), a detailed itemization of how the funds were spent must be included in the explanation.
  - If the special circumstance is medical/dental expense not covered by insurance, attach an itemized list of all expenses, insurance payments and net amounts after insurance.

**Copies of 2022 tax return** for student (spouse or parent, if applicable). For non-tax filers, we will accept 2022 W-2's, and/or unemployment benefits statements.
