

**Whatcom Community College (WCC)**  
**FHS Running Start Course Equivalencies**  
**Fall 2024 and Beyond**



Running Start funds classes that are 100 level or higher.

Running Start does **not** fund developmental classes 99 level or lower.

**Credit Equivalency**

Each 100 and above class taken at Whatcom Community College (WCC) will be transcribed at FHS based on the following equivalency chart. Any developmental courses at WCC will receive 0.5 FHS credit. Developmental courses that are 1 or 2 WCC credits will not receive any FHS credit.

<b>Math</b>	Any Math class 100 level or higher. Alg IIa = Math 98; Alg IIb = Math 99 (Running Start funding is not available for classes numbered 99 and below)
<b>Science</b>	Any 100 level or higher class from the following departments: Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Geology, Oceanography, Physical Science, Physics
<b>CTE or Occupational Ed.</b>	Psych 105 (Career Search Process), ARTGR 280, or 281 <b>OR</b> <u>Any 100 level or above course from the following departments:</u> Accounting, Administration of Justice, Business, Hospitality and Tourism Business Management, Business Technology, Computer Information Systems, Computer Science, Criminal Justice, Early Childhood Education, Education, Medical Assisting, Nursing, Office Administration, COOP 180 & 190, Paralegal Studies, & Software Development.
<b>US History</b>	HIST& 148
<b>Pacific Northwest History</b>	HIST& 214 - 1.0 elective credit; meets PNW Grad. Req. *not offered every quarter- check availability
<b>Civics</b>	POLS& 202 - FHS credit= 0.5 civics and 0.5 CWP
<b>CWP (Contemporary World Problems)</b>	<u>One of the following:</u> ANTH& 100 ANTH& 206 BUS& 201 ECON 100 ECON& 201 ECON& 202 GEOG& 102 HIST 225 POLS& 203 SOC 220
<b>Fine Arts</b>	Any art, Music, Drama, or Film course. Dance 101 and Dance 102
<b>Elective</b>	Any class 100 level or higher.
