## **Additional Graduation Requirements**

- 1. Be at least 18 years of age at the time of graduation or obtain high school release for early graduation.
- Students who began high school after July 1, 2004 (graduating classes of 2008 and beyond), must complete a Culminating Project. If under age 21 at time of graduation from WCC, they must also pass the 10<sup>th</sup> grade WASL.
- Students who graduate from WCC under age 21 who began high school prior to July 1, 2004 (graduating classes prior to 2008), will not be required to do a Culminating project or pass the 10<sup>th</sup> grade WASL, regardless of age at time of graduation.
