The Board of Trustees recognizes the vision and foresight of the Associated Students of Whatcom Community College to assess themselves voluntarily for projects and educational support services that would not otherwise be funded by state dollars. RCW 28B.15.610 authorizes students to impose these fees for student purposes, beyond and outside the authority of the services and activities fee statutes found in RCW 28B.15.041. Student-assessed fees approved by the Associated Students of Whatcom Community College require adoption by the Board of Trustees.

## Current fees fulfill the following purposes:

- The Comprehensive Fee is to be used for educational support services that would otherwise require a variety of additional, individual fees.
- The Student Recreation Center Fee is to be used for the design, construction, and operational support of the pavilion and recreation center.
- The Technology Fee is charged to students to recover, in whole or in part, the costs of providing, maintaining, and updating technology services to students.
