TITLE: Parking Regulations and Fines

NUMBER: 1121 AUTHORIZED BY PRESIDENT: 08/30/05

Purpose:

Accessible parking is important to every person coming on our campus. Parking is free at WCC, and students may park in any non-visitor lot. There is sufficient parking on campus, supporting easy access to all buildings.

All employees, students and visitors are expected to obey traffic and campus parking regulations, as instituted by law or by campus signage (Chapter 132U-116 WAC). Rules pertaining to No-parking areas (visitor and handicapped spaces, fire lanes and loading zones) in particular, are to be observed.

Early each quarter, the college will attempt to make students aware of parking policy as well as options for parking throughout campus. People will be encouraged to park in the North lots to minimize parking frustrations.

Process:

Facilities staff monitors all parking lots on campus. Specific locations, such as Food Service, Bookstore and Copy Duplicating monitor use of their loading zones.

Tickets are issued to cars parked illegally in:

- Fire Lane/Yellow Curb/ WCC Van parking only
- Roadway / No Parking Zones / Delivery / Service Driveways
- Visitor Parking Only (if not signed in at Information Desk)
- More than one space (Inconsiderate Parking)
- Disability Permit Required
- Construction Zones

Penalties:

Illegally parked vehicles shall be subject to ticketing, fines, and penalties up to vehicle removal.

Parking Fines

First Offense

Disability Parking	\$25
Fire Lane/Red or Yellow Curb	\$15
Visitor Parking	\$15
Loading Zone	\$15
All others	\$15

Second Offense

Double fines of first offense

Enforcement: Until the ticket is paid, student records may be withheld, and registration privileges blocked.

Appeal:

Individuals wishing to appeal the ticket must fill out a Parking Ticket Appeal and submit it to the Assistant to the Vice President for Educational Services, or designee.

Abandoned Vehicles:

When possible, owners of abandoned vehicles are notified by phone, letter and certified mail, that their car must be removed within ten days. If car is not removed by the owner, it is towed at WCC expense. The owner must pay to remove it from impound.
