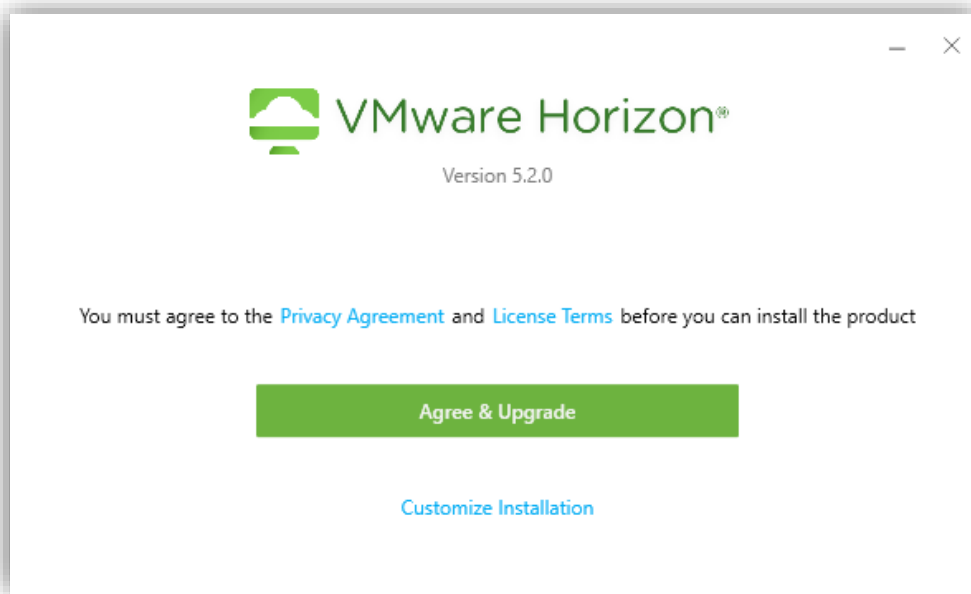
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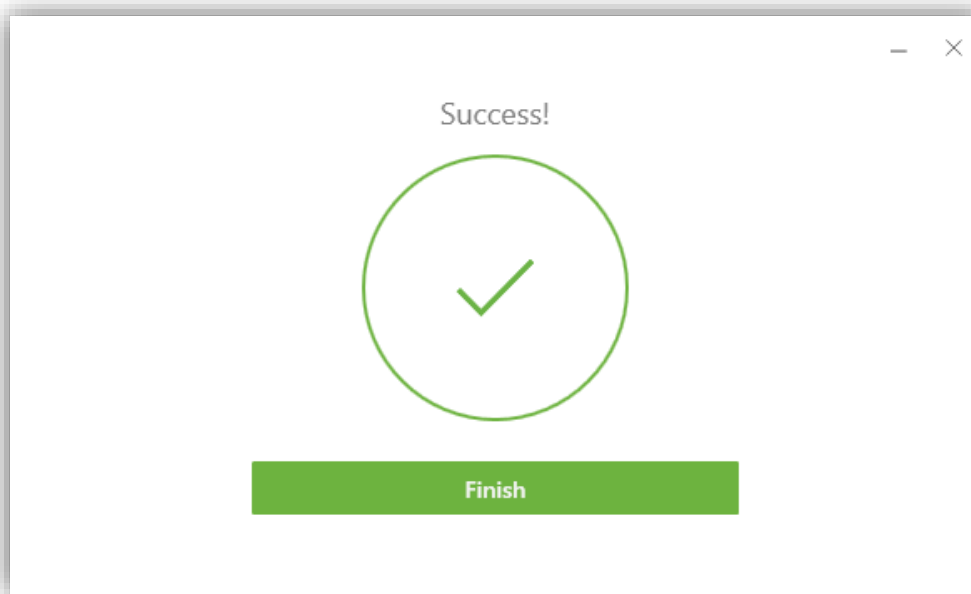

4. Double-click the “VMware Horizon.exe” file in your **Downloads** folder.

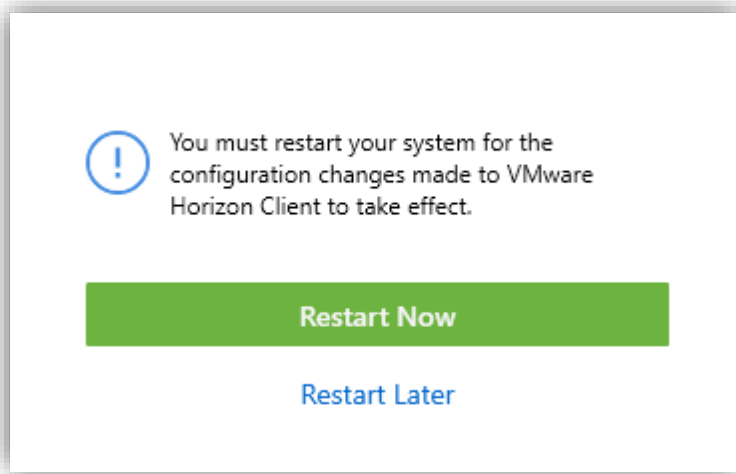
5. Click **Agree & Install** if this is your first time installing, or **Agree & Upgrade** if you already have VMware installed, but need to update your version.



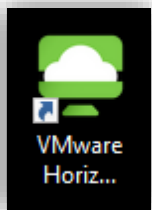
6. At the Success window, click **Finish**



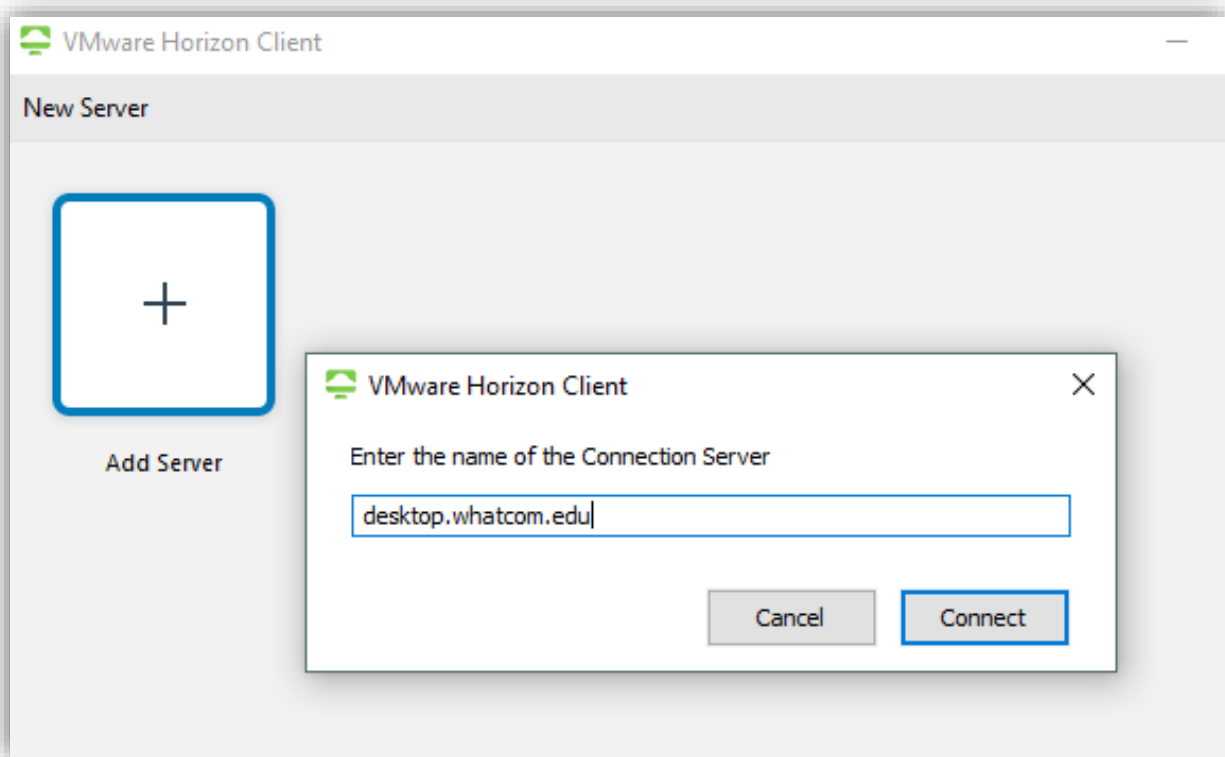
7. Click Restart Now

9. Click **Add Server** and enter: **desktop.whatcom.edu**




10. **Double-click** the box that says desktop.whatcom.edu
