1. I understand that English 92 and 95 are recommended preparation for this course, and I will need to do a significant amount of reading to be successful.
2. I have paid the \$25 application fee and \$11 Washington State Patrol background inquiry fee (valid for up to six [6] months). I understand that if I have a positive finding (a crime) on my background check, I may not be able complete the clinical experiences, and therefore could not pass the class.

Note: The application fee is non-refundable. If you are not admitted to this program with your initial application, there will be no refund of the fee. If you reapply to **within one year**, you will not need to pay the application fee again. New background check fees must be paid if your background check was run more than six months prior to the session for which you are applying.

3. I have enclosed results from my two-step Tuberculin Skin Test (TST). Two steps means the test will be placed twice, 1-3 weeks apart, with a reading after each placement – *two placements, two readings*. Negative test results are enclosed with this application. **NOTE:** Two negative test results are required to be considered negative for TB. If any TSTs are positive, a chest x-ray with written results and physician’s statement of no symptoms of TB is required. (TS tests can be done at walk-in clinics, any physician’s office, or Whatcom Occupational Health [360-676-1693].)
4. In addition to tuition, there is a \$75 materials fee for this program, payable on enrollment.
5. I understand that the certification exam fee is not included in the fees to the college (costs vary).
