## Associate in Arts \& Sciences (AAS/DTA) Degree Requirements

## Core courses

- Two courses in English composition (CC), including ENGL\& $101 \quad$ 6-10 credits
- One course in oral communication skills (OC)

3-5 credits
Note: CC and OC must add up to at least 10 credits
10-15 credits

- One course in quantitative/symbolic reasoning (O/SR)

5 credits

## Distribution courses

- Humanities ( $\mathbf{H}$ ); at least two disciplines

15 credits

- No more than 5 credits in performance (p) courses
- No more than 5 credits in 100 -level world languages
- No more than 5 credits in independent study
- HUM or IDS courses of 6 or more credits meet two-discipline requirement; must still have 15 total credits of humanities
- Social/Behavioral Sciences (SS); at least two disciplines 15 credits
- No more than 5 credits in independent study
- Math/Science (MS or MSI); at least two disciplines

15 credits

- At least one course designated as a lab course (I)
- At least 10 credits in physical/biological sciences
- No more than 5 credits in independent study


## Electives

- Additional elective credits to reach 90 -credit minimum for degree $25-30$ credits
- No more than 15 credits in unlisted electives (UE)
- No more than 3 credits in activity PE
- No more than 15 credits in independent study


## Other requirements

- One of the distribution courses or electives must be writing-intensive ( $\mathbf{w}$ )
- One of the distribution courses or electives must be in the diversity studies category (d)
- One of the distribution courses or electives must be in the global studies category (g)
- One of the distribution courses or electives must be in the sustainability category (s) Note: many courses meet more than one of the $\mathrm{w} / \mathrm{d} / \mathrm{g} / \mathrm{s}$ requirements at the same time.
- At least 15 of the credits applied to this degree must be earned at Whatcom Community College
