You must pay two non-refundable fees to apply to the Bachelor of Applied Science in Social Work (BASSW) program, a **\$50** application fee and an **\$11** Washington State Patrol Background Check fee. Your application will not be processed until these fees have been received. You may pay the fees in one of three ways:

- 1) In person at the WCC cashier’s office, located in the Laidlaw Center building, 237 W. Kellogg Road, Bellingham, WA 98226.
- 2) By mailing a check **with this completed form** to WCC Business Office, ATTN: BASSW Application Fees, Laidlaw Center, 237 W. Kellogg Road, Bellingham, WA 98226. Make check payable to, “Whatcom Community College.” **Do not mail your fees with your BASSW application.**
- 3) Over the phone with a credit card at 360-383-3363. You must provide your ctcLink ID number (EMPLID).

1. Why did you choose to pursue a degree in social work?
2. What are your personal strengths and how do these relate to your ability to be successful in the BASSW program? Be specific.
3. What does social justice mean to you?
4. Describe your social supports for successful completion of the program.

The following overall criteria will also be evaluated in the personal statement:

1. Ability to follow directions.
2. Ability to organize thoughts.
3. Ability to express oneself in writing.
